


Setup Content Rights

1. Open AppStore Connect. Log-in to your account
2. Click App Information on the left-hand side under General
3. Under General Information > Content Rights, click **Set Up Content Rights**
4. Select **No** then click **Done**

Adding Webhook Notification to App Information

This step is important to sync your iOS app to Passion.io. When your user cancels their subscription, it removes their subscription properly.

5. Under **App Store Server Notifications**, add https://passion.io/api/v1/webhooks/apple/webhook_notification in both Set Up URL (Production Server and Sandbox Server)
